Baby Puppy Dog

1st Pynegar's Check Mate at Berwynfa

Smart brindle, super head and expression giving him the edge in this class. Super topline and tailset, short back, good leg length, great bone and feet. sufficient forechest for his age. Smooth well laid shoulder, could have a better return of upper arm. Stylish on the move.

2nd Carter's Farvalley Major Luke at Susancar

Beautiful body shape on this immature baby. Super rear angulation. Strong solid topline. Front assembly exceptional. Good bone and feet. Just needing to mature and finish in face to realise his super potential.

Baby Puppy Bitch

1st Pynegar's Skies The Limit with Berwynfa BBPIS

Brindle, litter sister to the winner of the baby puppy dog. She's a lot like him but has the return of upper arm and therefore a better front assembly giving her the edge for best BBPIS. Gorgeous head, feminine, plenty bone and substance. Really good rear assembly highlighted on the move where she moves with good drive.

2nd McDonald's Yeteb Little Miss Splendid

Another Brindle puppy that was given away a lot in age. She was very close up here. Lovely shape and outline. Super head and expression. Really well constructed throughout. Has much potential, I'll be interested to see how she develops.

Minor Puppy Dog

Difficult class two Brindles

The winner Law's Shellark Giant Killing six months old not enjoying the floor but his super construction, super outline, and nice head and expressions gave home the edge to win the class.

2nd Slaney's Ellcrys Hephaestus at Slanstorm

Stronger made youngster with more bone and more masculine. Good profile movement.

Puppy Dog

1st Humphries Lanfrese Cantaro at Chribanna BPD RBPIS

Dark brindle white trim, very flashy. His head is super in profile and he uses his neat ears to advantage, he could just have a slightly softer eye expression. Super masculine, really super outline, short back, up on leg. Super front assembly and corresponding good rear assembly. Super bone and feet. Good crested neck. Ideal size. Nice and sound on the move

2nd Slaney's Normybox Monkey Man at Slanstorm

Brindle, only seven months old, really baby and looking very immature here. Masculine head, shoulders a little bit straight and his return of upper arm could be better, quite sound on the move.

Junior Dog

1st Johnson & Pynegar's Sashbob Never Would I Ever from Berwynfa RBD

Alone in this class this is a very handsome stallion male, masculine head really super plush foreface. Correct stop, good ears. Muscular crested neck onto a really super topline with a perfect tail. Super rear assembly. Shoulders could be a little more smooth. good forechest, super bone and feet. On the move he's really stylish with super carriage. Sound up and down. Maintains his excellent silhouette in motion.

Novice Dog

1st Smith's Slanstorm Supernatural Dean

Masculine red, 2 years and fully mature. I think we could describe him as a good honest sort. Super head and soft eye expression, foreface is super. Good bones and substance. Topline falls away a little bit towards the rear, could have more angulation, on the move although sound could have more reach and drive. Nice quality.

Post Graduate Dog

1st Van-Beck's Newlaithe Respect JW BD BOS

Two brindle youngsters headed this class. The winner is ideal for size, good headpiece. Good neck, really good shoulders and a prominent forechest. Good bone with slightly sloping pasterns and neat feet. Really good underline and top line. Good tailset with some shelf behind the tail. Sufficient angulation in the rear. Light on his feet, sound up and down and attractive side gait. Overall quality youngster.

2nd Louis' Boxania Over The Moon

Darker brindle again masculine good expression neat ears. Attractive outline with excellent proportions. Good bone good feet, super topline, sufficient rear angulation. On the move just doesn't open up and have as much reach and drive as much as the winner.

Limit Dog

1st Fox's Britesparke Norman Moon

Brindle, really outstanding head with a super soft expression, his expressive eyes are full dark and well placed. Super profile to his head. Sufficient neck shoulders are slightly sloping, a little more return of upper arm. Good bone good feet. Pasterns are a little straight. Very nice outline with a short back and up on leg. Would like a little more width across the stifle. On the move he is sound with good profile movement, maintaining a nice outline.

2nd Law & Pynegar's Shellark Spence Is Dynamite with Berwynfa

Darker brindle, head masculine, eye expressions could be softer. He's got a good neck, good shoulders and upper arm. Good feet. Topline falls away slightly to his tail and he could just do a little bit more width across the stifle. A little unsettled on the move.

Open Dog

1st McDonald's Yeteb Totally Charming JW

Masculine brindle, up on leg, nice outline. His head is masculine with a good wide foreface. Eye slightly light which detracts a little from his expression. Sufficient neck. Shoulders a little straight, prominent fore chest. Good bone and feet, sufficient depth of chest. Rib cage could be longer. Rear assembly extremely good with good width the cross the stifle. Excellent tail set with prominent shelf behind his tail. On the movie sound, maintaining a good outline.

Veteran Dog / Bitch

1st Louis' Rameleon Nights In Harlem BVIS

Brindle 10 years old. Lovely head and expression. Neat ears, sufficient length of neck, shoulder good with sufficient return of upper arm. Moderate size. Super bone and substance. Proportions are good. Well filled in chest. Good depth. top line is strong. Super rear, lots of width across the stifle. In super condition for his age. Sound with nice profile movement.

Minor Puppy Bitch

Really outstanding class of puppies.

1st McCarthy & Gething's Lorrosa My Heads Been Turned to Jeddhi

The winner's head is exquisite. I loved her beautiful eye expression. Ideal bone and great feet. Super outline, beautifully made throughout, with good front and rear assemblies. Good fill of chest. Excellent outline and proportions. Sound and stylish on the move.

2nd Fay-Smith's Lorrosa My Type On Paper

Very elegant puppy, close up to the winner, crested neck, super front angulation. Topline and tailset good. Super strong rear which she uses to advantage.

Puppy Bitch

1st Parker & Martin's Olleyville Odelia BPB BPIS

The winner has a glorious had an expression. Long crested neck. shoulders are okay, well filled forechest. Could have a little bit more length of rib. Strong topline, a good rear angulation with plenty of muscular condition and when she moves, she has a super big side gait and is sound up and down. Really nice quality.

2nd Pynegar's Kajobox Lady Billion from Berwynfa

More compact, but a little bit thicker through the shoulder. Just sufficient length of neck. A very high-quality bitch with a very nice expression. Feminine, good bone and feet. Good forechest, good depth, super top line. Really perfect tail set. Sound on the move.

Junior Bitch

1st McCarthy & Gething's Jeddhi Ring Of Fire BB BIS

feminine Brindle. smart. lovely head and wonderful eye expression, muscular arched neck. A well laid shoulder. Solidly built with good bone and substance and depth of rib. Ideal rear angulation with good width and musculature. Smart outline, short with good length of leg, she maintains this outline on the move. very good profile action with open side gait.

Yearling Bitch

1st Law's Shellark Abbey Road

Difficult class the winner is a really well-made bitch with beautiful confirmation. Good head and eye. Good shoulders and upper arm, strong limbs with slightly sloping pasterns. Good length of neck onto a good topline and correct tailset. Correct rear assembly with short strong hocks. Sound on the move.

2nd Fay-Smith's Lorrosa Missy Elliot

Pale brindle bitch with a long-refined arch neck, shoulders could be a little more laid back, excellent upper arm and forechest all correct. Good top line and tail set, good rear angulation. Not quite so positive on the move as the winner.

Novice Bitch

1st Johnson's Ini Mini Myni Mo at Berwynfa

Taller very elegant with a super outline. Long crested neck. head is attractive. Well laid shoulder shoulders, upper arms a little straight. Could have a touch more flexibility in pastern. Superb tailset, sufficient rear regulation. Presents a good outline and proportions. super stylish on the move.

2nd Fay-Smith's Lorrosa Seniorita

Super head and eye. Long crested neck. Shoulders are a little straight which impacts on her top line. Super fill in of chest. Good flexibility in pastern. Super rear angulation. Good shelf behind a super high set tail. Sound on the move

Post Graduate Bitch

1st Humphries' Chribanna Good Timin' RBB RBIS

Easy winner here. Very nice head and expression. Presents a really super outline. She's elegant and feminine with a long neck and super topline and tailset. Good front assembly, sufficient forechest. A little straight in pastern. Good rear angulation. On the move she's sound from every angle and she maintains a super outline.

2nd Chell's Joru Time For Change for Ludic

Really flashy brindle. Not quite type the expression of the winner. Super compact and solid in body. Good top line and tailset, good bone and feet. Text book rear with good width across the stifle. Sound.

Limit Bitch

1st Lott's Britesparke Eliza Mai

Pale brindle. Super front assembly. Good head and expression. Good feet with slight flexibility in the in the pastern super topline and underline. Excellent proportions. Really super rear regulation. On the move, sound although a touch wide in front, good profile movement.

Open Bitch

1st Fay-Smith's All That She Wants with Lorrosa

Attractive brindle, ideal size, feminine. Lovely head expression. Super outline and proportions. Moderate neck. Very good front assembly. Prominent forechest, good bone. Strong topline, just falls away slightly before the tail. Sufficient rear angulation. Good on the up and back and very attractive side gait.
